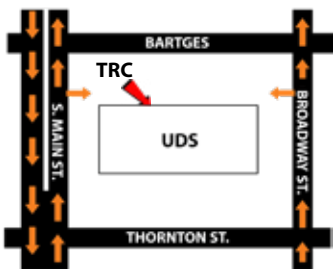




Why buy when you can borrow?
