Why buy toys when you can borrow them?

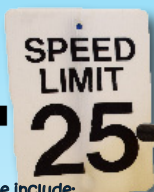
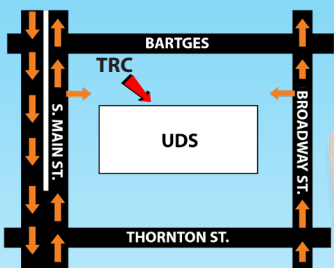

We have new toys!

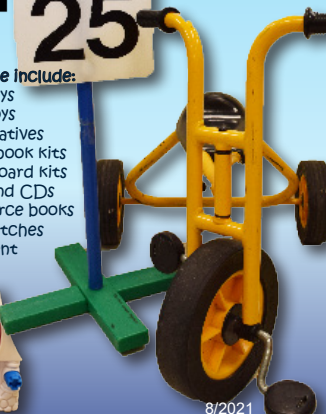
