In addition to toys, we also offer a selection of sensory tools, adapted items and switches. Therefore, individuals who assist adults and/or children benefiting from such apparatus are also welcome to join. Membership is NOT limited to residents within Summit County.

#### **Membership Fees and Guidelines**

Fees are contingent upon the type of membership acquired. Please refer to the chart below as it pertains to your individual needs. Members will complete a membership form annually and are individually responsible for items checked out. Accountability is imperative so that everyone is able to enjoy the benefits offered by the Center. Fees for damaged and lost items will be assessed and incurred by the borrower. Children learn responsibility and citizenship from caring for property ~ so thank you for your efforts to build this skill set with little ones!

Items may be renewed for <u>one borrowing period</u> provided the items are not on reserve.
