Go on a Literary Journey with the BraVo! Book Club



Reading is such a joy for our friends in BraVo! who have been staying busy diving into literary treasures thanks to their weekly book club. Originally a pilot initiative

started in 2017 between the Goodyear branch of the **Akron-Summit County Public Library** and BraVo!, the book club got its start after BraVd team members made a series of trips to the branch for a variety of activities.

Composed of two different teams, Branch Manager and Adult Services Librarian Tonya Gardella leads the Goodyear branch, whereas Adult Services Librarian Greg Trask leads the Northwest library team.

Typically meeting for an hour once a week—either at UDS or another location—groups read a portion of their book aloud and then discuss the themes and topics of the selection. "It is an opportunity for individuals to gather socially and it offers people a chance to engage intellectually," Trask says.

Along with questions and discussions, BraVd also engages in culminating events related to the selected book. For example, when a team finished *From the Mixed-Up Files of Mrs. Basil E. Frankweiler* by E.L. Konigsburg, which follows the story of two children running away from home to live in an art museum, the team visited the **Akron Art Museum** as a tie into the book theme (pictured above).

"We're all different in different ways," says Gardella, "but it doesn't have to be the focus of every story. You want to be able to see other aspects of yourself."

If you would like to read some of the books BraVd has enjoyed, suggestions include Pax by Sara Pennypacker, The City of Ember (Book One) by Jeanne DuPrau and Island of the Blue Dolphin by Scott O'Dell.
